  [ can, could, may, might, must, should, will, would, etc. ]
IDEA 2 | Some regular verbs can be followed by an infinitive (to + verb).
  Rob needs to do an interview. ✓
  Rob needs do an interview. X
  What do you want to do? ✓
  What do you want doing? X
  They plan to meet at 12 o'clock. ✓
  They plan meet at 12 o'clock. X
  [ decide, expect, hope, need, offer, plan, pretend, promise, want, *would like, etc. ]
IDEA 3 | Some regular verbs can be followed by a gerund (verb+ing).
  They often go cycling. \checkmark
  They often go to cycle. X
  He suggests renting bikes. ✓
  He suggests rent bikes. X
  She doesn't enjoy going to museums. ✓
  She doesn't enjoy to go to museums. X
  [ advise, avoid, consider, finish, go, keep, quit, recommend, regret, suggest, etc. ]
IDEA 4 Some regular verbs can be followed by an infinitive or a gerund. The meaning is essentially the same.
  Daniel starts talking to Rob. ✓
  Daniel starts to talk to Rob. ✓
  They like going to cafes. ✓
  They like to go to cafes. ✓
  [ begin, continue, hate, *like, love, prefer, start ]
IDEA 5 | Most regular (transitive) verbs can be followed by a noun (i.e. a direct object). Don't use "to" or "-ing".
  She wants an espresso. ✓
  She wants to espresso. X
  She wants to have an espresso. \checkmark
  Have you finished your coffee? ✓
  Have you finished to coffee? X
  Have you finished drinking your coffee? ✓
